Team Formation Rules (as per SIH 2025 Guidelines):

Each team must have exactly 6 members, including the Team Leader, with at least one female member.

- 1. All team members must be from the same institute. (No inter-college teams are allowed).
- 2. A team must have a unique name.
- 3. All members must have a valid Gmail ID and working phone number.
- 4. Team members can be from any branch and semester.
- 5. For Hardware Edition, interdisciplinary teams are encouraged (ME, EEE, CE, CSE, etc.).
- 6. Each team must nominate a Team Leader for all communications.

Internal Hackathon will tentatively be conducted in  $2^{nd}/3^{rd}$  week of September 2025. All the best!
